Abstract: The greater emphasis on the significance and difference in English performance between the school types has mainly been investigated across Asian countries. However, not much is known about what language skills differentiate their overall language achievement. Using an English test, this study measured the reading and listening skills of 1,319 Indonesian students who were selected using a stratified sample design and grouped them into secular (Sekolah, n=726) and Islamic (Madrasah, n=593) groups. The three-way ANOVA results showed a significant difference (p<0.05) in reading and listening subskills between the groups. Highly significant results of Madrasah students in reading and listening subskills indicate they are better at constructing what text means in a variety of contexts, as a literary experience in reading texts and obtaining general and specific information from listening tests compared to those attending secular schools.
